



INFORMATION CLAUSE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA
at the National Center for Nuclear Research
for persons who have consented to the processing of the image

According to Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR), we would like to inform you that:

1. The Controller of your personal data is the National Center for Nuclear Research (hereinafter referred to as NCBJ) with its registered office in Otwock, Andrzeja Soltana 7, 05-400 Otwock.
2. You may contact the Data Protection Officer at NCBJ at the address given above or at the address iod@ncbj.gov.pl.
3. The personal data Controller processes your personal data on the basis of consent. You have a right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
4. Your personal data is processed for the purpose of:

Purpose of processing	Legal basis for processing
Recording, multiplying by any technique and disseminating your image (appearance/voice/statement) for purposes related to the promotion of NCBJ, marketing, training/workshops/conferences and statutory interests of NCBJ, e.g. education and information.	The prerequisite for legalizing the processing is the consent (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR) In the case of pursuing claims, processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests by the Controller (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR)

5. Your personal data will be stored for the period necessary to achieve the objectives set out in point 4, in accordance with the regulations and taking into account the period of pursuing claims.
6. In connection with the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights:
 - 1) the right to access personal data and receive a copy thereof,
 - 2) the right to request rectification of personal data,
 - 3) the right to request the deletion of personal data,
 - 4) the right to request restriction of personal data processing,
 - 5) the right to request the transfer of personal data
 - 6) the right to object
 - 7) the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw.
7. You will not be subject to automated decision-making by NCBJ, including profiling.
